

Update on Coronavirus

Communication:

Cleaning:

- Epicenter are taking all measures to keep the building clean at all times. We have increased our cleaning routine at Epicenter. And we are, in particular disinfect surfaces with a lot of touch points such as tables, screens and door handles.

Work from home:

- It has been recommended to avoid larger groups of people. As a result of this, the Norwegian Health Authority now advice those who can, to work remote from home. Epicenter therefor encourages all members and visitors to take proper precautions.

- Epicenter Oslo has as of, Wednesday 11th March, reduced opening hours in our Service Desk to 08.30-16.00 Monday to Friday until Friday 3rd April. We will do this, to dedicate staff to maintain the building and keep all areas safe for those who need to work from Epicenter. All community activities are postponed until Friday 3rd April.
